COOKIES POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

DXA SEYCHELLES LIMITED owns and operates the brand "Highmarkets" (www.highmarkets.com). DXA SEYCHELLES LIMITED is duly registered in Seychelles with a registration number 8438281-1 and registered address at CT House, Office No. 9A, Providence, Mahe, Seychelles. Please refer to the website of the Company for more information. HIGHMARKETS is duly regulated by the FSA with License No SD218.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small data files. When you visit a website, the website sends the cookie to your computer. Your computer stores it in a file located inside your web browser.

Cookies do not carry viruses or malware to your computer. Since the data in a cookie remains unchanged during transmission, it cannot interfere with how your computer runs, but they act more like logs (i.e. they record user activity and remember stateful information) and they get updated every time you visit a website.

We may obtain information about you by accessing cookies, sent by our websites. Different types of cookies keep track of different activities. For example, session cookies are used only when a person is actively navigating a website. Once you leave the websites, the session cookie disappears. For a more detailed list of cookies we use, please read the relevant section below.

3. WHY ARE COOKIES USEFUL?

We use functional cookies to analyse how visitors interact with websites and to monitor and improve our websites' performance and function. This helps us deliver high-quality customer experience by quickly identifying and fixing any issues that may arise. For example, we might use cookies to keep track of which website pages are most popular and which method of linking between website pages is most effective. The latter also helps us to track if you were referred to us by another website and improve our future advertising campaigns.

Cookies are also used to store your log in sessions. For example, when you log in to the Members Area to deposit funds, a "session cookie" is set so that the websites remember that you have already logged in. If the website did not set this cookie, you will be asked for your login and password on each new page as you progress through the funding process.

In addition, functional cookies are used to remember your preferences and recognize you as a user, help keep your information secure and ensure the website operates reliably and efficiently. For example, these cookies save you from having to type in your username every time you access our trading platform, and recall your preferences, such as

your preferred language.

Here is an overview of some of the functions our cookies provide us with:

- Verifying your identity and detecting the country you are currently visiting from.
- Checking browser type and device.
- Tracking which site the user was referred to from.
- Allowing third parties to customize content accordingly.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

- **Functional cookies:** These cookies are essential for the running of our websites. Without these cookies our websites would not function properly. These are saved temporarily as login information and expire once the browser is closed.
- **Analytical cookies:** Analytical cookies provide information which allows us to identify patterns of visitor behavior. We use that information to enhance the overall experience or identify areas of the websites which may require maintenance. The information is anonymous (i.e. it cannot be used to identify you and does not contain personal information such as your name and email address) and it is only used for statistical purposes. Behavioral cookies function similarly to analytical and remember that you have visited a website and use that information to provide you with content which is tailored to your interests.
- **Promotional cookies:** These cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third party advertisers.
- **Preferences cookies:** Preference cookies allow a website to remember settings that influence the way said website functions or appears, such as your preferred language or the region that you are located in.

These websites use Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). 5. MANAGING COOKIES

You can delete cookies any time you want by using the settings in your web browser. You can also choose to disable cookies from your web browser, but this would mean that our websites and other websites may not function properly if you do this, and as a result you may not be able to sign in.

6. DO NOT TRACK (DNT) BROWSER SETTING

DNT is a feature offered by some browsers which, when enabled, sends a signal to websites to request that your browsing is not tracked, such as by third party ad networks, social networks and analytic companies. These websites do not currently respond to DNT requests.
